PROCEEDINGS:

Reading of the minutes of our last AGM by Mary Alice Ramsey:

Nominating Committee:

New Business:

President John Ramsay reported that our by-laws were drafted about 1972. In this document, all members of Clan Ramsay/Ramsey over age 15 can serve as an officer after nomination and election by the membership. Membership is open to all who can trace their ancestors to a Ramsay/Ramsey. Officially we have no Septs however the Lord Lion recognizes North American Ramsay/Ramsey's as; Dalhousie, Brechin and Maule.

By-laws Article #7 Recap: Clan Committee, Amendments to By-Laws. Proposal to change By-Laws to not require 30 days' written notice to members of a By-Laws change. All proposed changes to the By-Laws will be published in the **Ramsay Report** including both existing By-Laws and the proposed new change. In the absence of any objection during a 30 day the comment period, the proposed change will become final.

Dr. Carl Bailey commented on the recent additions of new members from other countries. Our official name should reflect this international involvement. President Ramsay reported that we now have Clan Ramsay/Ramsey members in France, Canada, England, New Zealand and Australia and our clan name needs to reflect an international name status.

Proposed global name change in our By-Laws: President John Ramsay entertained a motion that we accept all the proposed changes in our By-Laws. The changes will be published in the Spring edition of **Ramsay Report**. After a 30-day member review period; in the absence of any objection, said proposed changes will become final. Motion Carried.

Next meeting:

President John Ramsay asked for a recommended location for our next AGM. Following some discussion, the Stone Mountain Games in Stone Mountain, Georgia was approved. These games will be the third weekend in October 2017.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
